
### **Important Details**

- There are no separate seats/quota for students based on region, ethnicity, religion, and extracurricular activities.
- Students must meet and exceed both eligibility criteria in order to be shortlisted for the NOP SCS.
- Coaching session attendees will be examined through different exercises/tests and successful candidates will be registered for the LUMS Admission Test completely paid for by LUMS.
- All students, irrespective of whether they apply directly or through the NOP, are evaluated on the same admission and financial need evaluation criteria.
- While assessing financial need, a review committee ensures transparency in the process of awarding scholarships to all those who qualify for admission. This process is carried out annually throughout a student's study tenure at LUMS.

# What is the National Outreach Programme (NOP)?

The NOP is a scholarship established in 2001 at LUMS. Its singular aim has been to bring together the brightest minds from all over the country to study at Pakistan's premier institution with full scholastic aid. We travel to far-flung villages and the most prominent cities across all provinces of the country to inform eligible applicants of the NOP Summer Coaching Session (SCS), which is the first step towards attaining the scholarship for undergraduate studies at LUMS. With the NOP, a lack of financial resources will never be a barrier to achieving your dreams of academic excellence!

## Who Can Apply?

If you have at least 80% marks in Matric or equivalent in O-Levels and have a need for financial assistance



### How to Apply?

Students who meet the eligibility criteria can apply through the following process:

#### **Step 1 – Application Process**

Students apply to the NOP SCS when they are in the first year of Intermediate or A-Levels. Students attending the coaching session in 2023 will be able to join LUMS undergraduate programmes in 2024. You can fill out your online application at nopscs.lums.edu.pk.

#### Step 2 – Summer Coaching Session (SCS)

Shortlisted candidates will be called in for a twoweek long summer coaching session at LUMS to experience university life and prepare for the University's Admision Test. The session will be arranged during the summer holidays and all expenses, except travelling, will be covered by LUMS. Attending the session does not guarantee admission or a scholarship award.

#### **Step 3 – Test Registration**

LUMS will pay the one-time admission fee of candidates who successfully complete the summer coaching session and meet all academic and scholarship parameters.

#### Step 4 – LUMS Admission Form

Successful NOP summer coaching session candidates then fill out an online application for admission to LUMS through the following link: admissions.lums.edu.pk.

Qualifying students who meet the set academic and financial evaluation benchmark will become LUMS NOP scholars!
